## **BILL INTRODUCTION**

Local governments in Maryland are granted the power under federal and state law to have their own local clean air or solid waste laws that are at least as strict as the state and federal minimums. However, courts have not honored this, and there is a need to clarify state law.

In the Maryland 2023 legislative session, Delegate Bridge's bill would empower counties and municipalities to pass local laws that could bring old industrial polluters up to modern standards or require real-time monitoring of toxic pollutants that are currently monitored once a year (if at all).
